SUBJECT: License Agreement between Oakland -Alameda County Joint Powers Authority and Oakland Pro soccer LLC.

A resolution authorizing the City Administrator to approve a license Resolution authorizing the City Administrator to approve a license agreement between the Oakland and Alameda County Joint Powers Authority and Oakland Pro Soccer LLC, Subject to approval by the County of Alameda, and Certain other Contingencies, for a term ending the earlier of December 21, 2026 or the date when either the City or County convey its ownership interest in the Coliseum complex, and for flat event expense fees between 138,000 to 300,000 per game day event and a base license fee of 1,500 per month for a storage area.

Colleagues on the City Council and Members of the Public,

I am writing in support of the above resolution authorizing the City Administrator to approve a license agreement between the Oakland and Alameda County Joint Powers Authority (JPA) and Oakland Pro Soccer LLC, subject to approval by the County of Alameda and other applicable contingencies. This agreement represents a meaningful and strategic step toward ensuring that the Coliseum complex remains an active and vibrant community asset during this transitional period. By authorizing this license, the City and County can sustain professional sports programming that draws visitors, generates economic activity, and fosters community pride and engagement.
