WHEREAS, the City of Oakland wishes to create resilient and safe communities through the Oakland City-County Violence Prevention Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Youth Ambassadors Program in the West Oakland target area will engage youth in organizing projects that will provide constructive activities for young people and contribute to the prevention of violence; and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Foundation has awarded the City of Oakland a grant of \$15,000 to support the Youth Ambassadors Program in the West Oakland target area over a nine month period from February 2005 through October 2005, and said funds shall be appropriated to Fund 2190, Organization 78111, and a project to be established; and

WHEREAS, there is no impact on the general fund and the City of Oakland shall receive \$15,000 to implement the Youth Ambassador Project; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to appropriate aforesaid grant to Fund 2190, Organization 78111, and a project to be established for the purposes described above; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That should the grantor make additional funds available as part of this grant, the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to appropriate additional funds to the same fund, organization and project as above; and, be it further

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator or her designee as a gent for the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary for completion of the aforementioned grant in accordance with its basic purpose.
