INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER LYNETTE GIBSON MCELHANEY

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$11,000 FROM COUNCILMEMBER MCELHANEY'S ANTI-GRAFFITI MURAL AND GREEN WALL FUNDS TO ATTITUDINAL HEALING CONNECTION TO INSTALL A MURAL ON THE M. ROBINSON BAKER YMCA IN WEST OAKLAND

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the City Council adopted a budget that set aside Anti-Graffiti funds for Murals and Green Walls for council members to grant to address graffiti within their districts; and

WHEREAS, any expenditures for purposes other than City or other governmental infrastructure, furniture, or equipment require council approval; and

WHEREAS, the wall on the Brockhurst side of the M. Robinson Baker YMCA is currently in a state of graffiti blight; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Attitudinal Healing Connection's plan, the bulk of the painting will be carried out during the City County Neighborhood Initiative's Friday Night Live events to generate community involvement; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember McElhaney wishes to grant a portion of her Anti-Graffiti Mural and Green Wall Funds to Attitudinal Healing Connection to install a mural on the M. Robinson Baker YMCA in West Oakland to abate and deter graffiti; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements, the Attitudinal Healing Connection will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Anti-Graffiti Mural and Green Wall funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the grant of \$11,000 from Councilmember Lynette Gibson McElhaney's Anti-Graffiti Mural and Green Wall funds to the Attitudinal Healing Connection to install a mural on the M. Robinson Baker YMCA in West Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to execute an appropriate grant agreement with the Attitudinal Healing Connection for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
