RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE HONORABLE CONGRESSWOMAN BARBARA LEE FOR HER YEARS OF DEDICATED LEADERSHIP IN THE FIGHT AGAINST HIV/AIDS

WHEREAS, Congresswoman Barbara Lee has fought on behalf of the 40 million people around the world living with the HIV/AIDS disease both locally and globally; and

WHEREAS, Congresswoman Lee's steadfastness and undaunting vision has lead to effective, bipartisan measures to help prevent the spread of HIV/AIDS; and

WHEREAS, Congresswoman Lee successfully passed meaningful legislation that will initiate multilateral international efforts to fight HIV/AIDS; and

WHEREAS, lifting the HIV/AIDS travel ban is consistent with the United States position as an international leader; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland applauds Congresswoman Lee for her leadership and compassion in leading these human rights efforts; and

WHEREAS, we salute Congresswoman Lee for her commitment to improving the quality of life for residents of the City of Oakland and the 9th Congressional District; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the elected officials, staff and citizens of Oakland are honored to recognize Congresswoman Barbara Lee for her outstanding service and contributions to the fight against HIV/AIDS; and be it
