INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER _____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE CALTRANS' SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIXTH CYCLE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS (\$384,912.00) FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS SCHOOL LOCATIONS CITYWIDE

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is responsible for disbursing state funds for the Safe Routes to School (SR2S) Program Sixth Cycle to local jurisdictions for construction projects that improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety along routes to schools; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland identified projects for said grant totaling \$427,680.00 in design and construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland applied for and was awarded SR2S Sixth Cycle funds in the amount of \$384,912.00; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide a local match of \$42,768.00 from the Measure B Fund (2211); Safe Routes to School 05-06 Project (C268710); and

WHEREAS, based on collaboration among the City's Transportation Services Division (TSD), Police Department, Pedestrian Safety Project Coordinator, Safe Walk to School Coordinator, and school officials, the following projects were identified for this funding: 1) Foothill Boulevard/22nd Avenue for Garfield Elementary; 2) 4th Avenue/East 12th Street for La Escuelita Elementary; 3) 73rd Avenue/Krause Avenue for Markham Elementary; 4) 10th Street/Alice Street for Lincoln Elementary; and 5) 11th Street/Alice Street for Lincoln Elementary; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorize the City Administrator or her designee to accept and appropriate the Safe Routes to School Program Sixth Cycle funds within the Caltrans Fund (2140); Transportation Services Division Organization (92246); and Project number to be determined in the amount of \$384,912.00; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee is authorized, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute and submit all documents, payment requests, and related actions, as well as to appropriate any additional grant funds received for the completion of this project; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreements authorized by resolution shall be reviewed and approved by the Office of the City Attorney and shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.


