RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$60,933.60) IN REIMBURSEMENT COSTS FROM THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI) FOR THE OVERTIME COSTS OF TWO (2) POLICE OFFICERS, FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2001 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2002, AND THE OVERTIME COSTS OF FOUR (4) POLICE OFFICERS, FROM OCTOBER 1, 2002 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2003, ASSIGNED TO THE SAFE STREETS VIOLENT CRIME/FUGITIVE TASK FORCE, TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (hereinafter "FBI") has formed a Safe Streets Violent Crime/Fugitive Task Force to investigate and prosecute crimes committed against the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department assigned two officers to participate in the Task Force for the period October 1, 2001 through September 30, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department increased its participation in the Task Force to four officers for the period of October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the FBI has agreed to reimburse the City for the direct overtime costs of officers assigned to the Task Force up to a maximum of \$821.52 per officer, per month for the period from October 1, 2001 through September 30, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the FBI has agreed to reimburse the City for overtime costs of officers assigned to the Task Force up to a maximum of \$858.69 per officer, per month for the period from October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the FBI will not reimburse the City for any indirect costs related to the performance of overtime service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept federal overtime reimbursement funds from the FBI in an amount not to exceed \$19,716.48 for the purpose of appropriating said funds to the Police Department for overtime costs of two (2) police officers assigned to the Safe Streets Violent Crime/Fugitive Task Force for the period October 1, 2001 to September 31, 2001; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept additional federal overtime reimbursement funds from the FBI in an amount not to exceed \$41,217.12 for the purpose of appropriating said funds to the Police Department for overtime costs of four (4) police officers assigned to the Safe Streets Violent Crime/Fugitive Task Force for the period October 1, 2002 to September 31, 2003; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Central Services overhead cost of approximately \$7,074.39 (11.61%) are hereby waived; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said funds shall be appropriated to Department of Justice Grant Fund No. 2112, in Org. No. 102210, and a Police Department Project number to be assigned.
