WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds totaling up to \$142,000 will be received from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Community Capacity Development Office, in support of third year program operations associated with the Elmhurst Weed and Seed Initiative in the City Administrator's Office, Neighborhood Services Division; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice provides funding through Weed and Seed Initiatives as a community-based, multi-agency partnership approach to law enforcement, crime prevention, and neighborhood restoration; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Elmhurst Weed and Seed Initiative will assist in the Police Department's goal of decreasing incidents of violent crime, gang violence, drug trafficking, and drug-related crime in targeted high-crime neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the proposed spending plan will facilitate the City Council's goal of crime reduction through City-wide community policing and other strategies; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount not to exceed \$142,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Program, Community Capacity Development Office, to be allocated to the Federal Grant Fund: 2112, City Administrator's Administrative Unit 02111, in a Program and Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That grant funds received for the Elmhurst Weed and Seed Initiative shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the City of Oakland; and be it
