

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO ROSAS BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CITYWIDE SIDEWALK REPAIRS (PROJECT NO. C317510) FOR THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$1,376,667.00)

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2009, five bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland for the Citywide on-call sidewalk repair (Project No. C317510); and

WHEREAS, Star Construction, bidding as a prime, is the lowest bidder but did not meet the City Trucking Participation requirement for the project; and

WHEREAS, Rosas Brothers Construction, a certified SLBE bidding as a prime, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the project; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work. Funding for this project is available in the following project account:

- Measure B-ACTIA Fund (2211), Capital Projects-Sidewalk Repair Maintenance Organization (92452), Street Construction Account (57411), Project No. C321510, \$1,000,000.00.
- Measure B-ACTIA Fund (2211), Capital Projects-Sidewalk Repair Maintenance Organization (92452), Street Construction Account (57411), Project No. C317510, \$164,610.00.
- Measure B-ACTIA Fund (2211), Capital Projects-Sidewalk Repair Maintenance Organization (92452), Street Construction Account (57411), Project No. C317910, \$297,565.00; and these funds were specifically allocated for this project. This project will help reduce the trip and fall, comply with Americans with Disabilities Act mandates and meet citizen demand; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy or better performance; and

WHEREAS, Rosas Brothers Construction complies with all LBE/SLBE and trucking requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the construction contract for the Citywide on-call curb ramp and sidewalk (Project No. C317510) is hereby awarded to Rosas Brothers Construction in accordance with the terms of its bid therefore, dated February 19, 2009, for the amount of one million three hundred seventy-six thousand, six hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$1,376,667.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Deputy Director of the Community and Economic Development Agency for this project are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance, \$1,376,667.00, and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for the amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, \$1,376,667.00, with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a construction contract with Rosas Brothers Construction on behalf of the City of Oakland and to execute any amendments or modifications to said agreement within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all other bids are hereby rejected; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the construction contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously forthwith notice of the above award on the official bulletin board in the Office of the City Clerk.


