RE: Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 12744 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule),

as Amended, to Establish, Modify, and Delete Fees Assessed by Selected Offices,

Departments, and Agencies of the City of Oakland

SUMMARY

The attached ordinance amends Ordinance Number 12744 C.M.S. (the FY 2006-07 Master Fee Schedule, or "MFS"), to establish, modify and delete fees and penalties assessed by the following agencies or departments: Office of the City Administrator, Office of the City Attorney, Office of the City Auditor, Office of the City Clerk, Community and Economic Development Agency, Department of Contracting and Purchasing, Finance and Management Agency, Fire Services Agency, Library, Cultural Arts/Museum, Office of Parks and Recreation, Police Services Agency, and Public Works Agency. In most cases, changes to fees are required to offset increases in costs related to the provision of services for which fees are charged. In areas where fee comparisons are applicable, the City of Oakland's fees are similar to other neighboring jurisdictions. Detailed explanations/justifications for fee changes are provided in the "Discussion" section below.

A public hearing has been scheduled to review the proposed fee changes. The meeting will take place at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance by the City Council, on June 14, 2007, at 4:00 pm or as soon as practically possible thereafter.

FISCAL IMPACT

The revenue from the proposed changes in fees will produce an estimated \$8.56 million. Of this amount, \$1.29 million will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (1010), \$0.42 million to the Multipurpose Reserve Fund (1750), and \$6.85 million to the Development Services Fund (2415). The anticipated additional revenue will help offset increases in costs to provide services for which the increased fees are charged, with no net gain. Both revenue and cost increases have already been anticipated in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

DISCUSSION

The following attachments are presented with this agenda report/proposed ordinance.

• Exhibit A to the ordinance reflects proposed changes to the Master Fee Schedule for FY2007-08. Proposed changes to the Master Fee Schedule added subsequent to the May

- 29, 2007 budget review session are highlighted on pages 8, 33, 34, 42, 43, 49, 50, 92, 93 and 94 of Exhibit A and described in Attachment C.
- Attachment A reflects changes previously adopted by the City Council, but not reflected in the published FY2006-07 Master Fee Schedule document, because they were approved after it had been published. Examples of such changes include the fee for collection of delinquent penalty payments and the Mills Act application and inspection fee.
- Attachment B provides responses to questions raised by the City Council during the May 29, 2007 budget review session.
- <u>Attachment C</u> provides a description of proposed changes to the Master Fee Schedule developed subsequent to the May 29, 2007 budget review session.

The Master Fee Schedule changes not yet approved by the City Council, and presented in <u>Exhibit A</u>, are summarized below, along with justifications and estimated revenue changes.

1. Office of the City Administrator (pages 1 - 2)

- The Budget Office has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees for the Budget-In-Brief and <u>add</u> a fee for the Midcycle Amended Budget book. In addition, the Budget Office has proposed to <u>revise</u> the title under the Oakland Redevelopment Agency to include the various books available. No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from these fee modifications as requests to purchase the budget books are few since the the documents are available online.
- The Executive Director of the Citizens' Police Review Board (CPRB) who also oversees special activity permits has proposed to <u>increase</u> its application filing fee and appeal filing fee for special activity and its fees for medical cannabis dispensary permits. The Executive Director has also proposed to <u>delete</u> its fees for charitable solicitation permits since it is captured in other fees and remove "Citizens' Police Review" from the section heading to better reflect actual services provided. The revenue increase of approximately \$27,500 will accrue in the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.
- KTOP has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees for duplication of DVDs and the rental rates
 for the film editing system. In addition, KTOP has proposed to <u>add</u> a new fee for
 rental of the XDCam camera. No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from
 these fee modifications as KTOP equipment are made available for rental, but are
 seldom rented.
- The Nuisance Enforcement Unit has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees for public nuisance and eviction. No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from these fee modifications.

 Contract Compliance and Employment Services fees are proposed to be moved to a new section titled Contracting & Purchasing, as this unit is no longer part of the City Administrator's Office.

2. City Attorney (page 3)

• The Office of the City Attorney has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees to reflect increased costs to provide services (due to MOU agreements and changes in the fringe benefit rate). No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from these fee modifications.

3. City Auditor (page 4)

• The Office of the City Auditor has proposed to increase its fees for Audit services to outside entities to offset the cost of providing the service. No change in overall revenue is anticipated from this fee modification.

4. City Clerk (page 5)

• The City Clerk has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fee for duplication of documents and passport photos to help offset the actual costs of providing these services. The revenue increase of approximately \$1,764 will accrue in the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

5. Contracting & Purchasing (page 6)

• Contract Compliance and Employment Services has proposed to <u>add</u> a service fee for certified payroll data collection software. No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from the fee modifications.

6. Oakland Public Library (page 7)

• The Oakland Public Library has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fee for overdue fines on adult materials other than video cassettes. The revenue increase of approximately \$130,200 per fiscal year will accrue in the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

7. Finance and Management Agency (page 8-10)

- The Finance and Management Agency (FMA) has proposed to <u>add</u> the following new fees: i) credit card convenience fee; ii) notary fee; iii) notice of violation fee; iv) fee to re-issue W2 form; and v) off-street parking meter fee at the Henry J. Kaiser Center parking lot. These fees will help offset the actual costs of providing these services.
- FMA has proposed an <u>increase</u> to its fee for duplication of document, collection fee

- on delinquent accounts, and residential permit parking (which was moved from Public Works Agency) to help offset the actual cost of providing these services.
- FMA has proposed to <u>eliminate</u> Information Technology fees as it's no longer part of FMA and are internal service fees only.
- In total, additional revenue of approximately \$447,644 will accrue in the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

8. Police Services Agency (pages 11 – 14)

- The Police Services Agency (PSA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> the following fees: i) dog license fees; ii) labor cost of officers when claiming an impounded animal; iii) disposal of dead animals service fee; and iv) fee for copying Communications Division voice tapes. The fee increases will help to offset rising costs of providing these services.
- The PSA has proposed to add the following <u>new fees</u>: i) Redemption Home Inspection fee; ii) taxicab permit missed appointment and re-inspection fees; iii) deposit fee for potentially dangerous and vicious dog hearings; iv) fees for animal shelter medical procedures; v) surrender of animal to the Oakland Animal Shelter fee; and vi) euthanasia fee of animal at the Oakland Animal Shelter. The new fees are proposed to help offset the actual costs of providing these services.
- PSA has proposed to <u>modify</u> the dog license renewal fee within 30 days and <u>revise</u> descriptions of fees to better reflect the services offered and fees being imposed.
- The estimated additional revenue of \$93,680 for FY2007-08 and \$42,560 for FY2008-09 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the Proposed FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

9. Fire Services Agency (pages 15-26)

- The Fire Services Agency (FSA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees by an average of five percent (5%) across the board, to reflect increased costs to provide services (driven by CPI and MOU increases).
- FSA has proposed to add <u>new</u> fees for fire code inspection, fire engine/truck, and <u>revise</u> the training fee. The new fees are proposed in order to reflect the actual services performed and help offset the cost of providing these services.
- FSA has proposed to <u>delete</u> various fees and <u>revise</u> descriptions and their placement on the MFS to better reflect the actual services performed. No revenue loss is

- anticipated from the deletions, as they are no longer applicable or have been revised and moved to another section.
- The revenue increase of approximately \$57,500 for FY2007-08 and \$60,550 for FY2008-09 will accrue in the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

10. Cultural Arts/Museum (pages 27 – 32)

- The Henry J. Kaiser Convention Center fees are proposed to be <u>eliminated</u> as they are no longer applicable. In addition, the Cultural Arts title is proposed to be removed as this section will now only include fees from the Museum.
- The Museum has proposed to <u>increase</u> its rental fees and the special event parking fee at the Oakland Museum parking garage to continue providing such services. Revenues anticipated from the above fee modifications will go towards the Oakland Museum of California Foundation.
- In addition, Museum has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fee for duplication of documents to offset the actual cost of providing the service. No changes in overall revenues are anticipated from this fee modification.

11. Office of Parks and Recreation (pages 33 – 50)

- The Office of Parks and Recreation (OPR) has proposed to <u>increase</u> the following fees: i) park use permits; ii) rental facilities; iii) usage of main stage/theatre, studio A,B,C,D, and recording studios at the Malonga Casquelourd Center; iv) lake sailing/boating classes, v) mariner day camps; vi) sailing into science classes; vii) swimming instruction for jr. lifeguard and youth swim team, viii) recreation day/overnight camps; and ix) golfing fees.
- OPR has proposed to <u>add</u> the following fees: i) non-resident and gymnasium fees at Studio One/recreation centers; and ii) new facilities, equipment and staff cost for rental at the Malonga Casquelourd Center.
- OPR has proposed to <u>decrease</u> some golfing fees to promote facility usage and <u>eliminate</u> those fees that are no longer applicable such as the park use permit fee for runs, walks, and related activities and the all-day fee for the Woodminster Amphitheatre.
- The revenue increase of approximately \$244,500 for FY2007-08 and \$247,000 for FY2008-09 will accrue in the General Purpose Fund (1010) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

• Lastly, the City Council, on January 11, 1994, adopted Resolution No. 70672 C.M.S. authorizing the collection of a ticket surcharge on the cost of all Paramount Theatre tickets sold. The Paramount Theatre ticket surcharge has not been adjusted for thirteen years. It is proposed that the surcharge be increased to \$1.00. This rate is consistent with the ticket surcharge that was in place for the theater at the Henry J. Kaiser Convention Center. Revenues anticipated from the above fee modifications will go towards the Paramount Theatre Endowment Fund for the purpose of maintaining and operating this facility.

12. Public Works Agency (pages 51 - 55)

- The Public Works Agency (PWA) has proposed to <u>increase</u> its fees for the following: i) duplication of documents; ii) engineering review; iii) rate for Clay Street and Dalziel garage; iv) security services for Civic Center Complex; v) boarding of windows and doors; and vi) service fees for billing outside parties or agencies for work performed to offset the actual costs of providing such services.
- PWA has proposed to <u>revise</u> some of its fee descriptions to better reflect the actual services performed. This included <u>adding</u> new service fees for billing outside parties or agencies, the appeal fee for tree removal permit and <u>eliminating</u> those fees that are no longer applicable.
- The revenue increase of approximately \$\frac{\$422,253}{253}\$ will accrue to the Multipurpose Reserve Fund (1750) and has been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

13. Community and Economic Development Agency (pages 56 – 94)

- The Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) has proposed to increase its fees by an average of four percent (4%) across the board to reflect increased costs to provide services.
- CEDA has proposed to add the following <u>new</u> fees: i) building sewer; ii) on-site storm drainage piping; iii) maintenance holes/catch basin; iv) request for general plan determination; and v) report fees under Applications under the Oakland Rezoning Regulation. In some instances, fees have been <u>revised</u> to better reflect the actual services performed or <u>deleted</u> as they are no longer applicable.
- Revenue increases of approximately \$285,779 will accrue to the General Purpose Fund (1010) and \$6,851,838 will accrue to the Development Services Fund (2415) and have been included in the FY 2007-09 Proposed Policy Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Once adopted, the amended fees will become effective on July 1, 2007. A public hearing has been scheduled to review the proposed fee changes at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance by the Council, on June 14, 2007, at 4:00 pm or as soon as practically possible thereafter. The second reading and adoption of the Master Fee Schedule has been scheduled for June 19, 2007.

Master Fee Schedule Questions/Responses May 29, 2007 ORA /City Council Budget Review

City Administrators Office

- 1. Citizens' Police Review and Special Activities (Page 1)
 - Outdoor Sound Amplification filed within 10 days of the Event

Question: How was fee calculated and what is fee used for?

Response: Guidelines state that an application for outdoor sound amplification needs to be submitted within ten days. This allows staff ample time to check if there is sufficient room at the location, fill out the permit and notify Oakland Police Department. Many people in the past have asked for a permit as late one day before the planned event. The proposed fee provides an incentive for the applicant to request the permit 10 days or more in advance.

- Appeal filing Fee, Special Activity Permits

Ouestion: How was fee calculated and what is fee used for?

Response: The fee was calculated to defray a portion of the cost for staff to research the issue, and process the appeal, including preparation of material for City Council review.

2. KTOP Smoke Edit System Hourly/Daily Fee (Page 2)

Question: Are we still competitive with marketplace?

Response: The proposed fee adjustments will bring City of Oakland rates more in line with market rates based upon research conducted of similar facilities throughout Northern California.

Finance and Management Agency

1. Credit Card Convenience Fee (Page 8)

Question: Who uses credit cards, how much revenue is collected and what are actual costs? Response: Within the Finance and Management Agency Revenue Division, credit cards are used by individuals and merchants to pay for a variety of fees and taxes including Business Tax, Parking Tax, Real Property Tax, Transient Occupancy Tax, Utility Users Tax, Collection Fees, Excess Litter Fees and Rent Program Services Fees. During the current fiscal year, the Finance and Management Agency, Revenue Division, has incurred credit card processing fees of \$117,000 on revenue of \$6 million, an average cost of 2 percent. Based upon comments raised at the May 29, 2007 budget session, the Finance and Management Agency recommends elimination of the proposed \$6 minimum charge. The original proposal of the greater of 2% of the amount paid or \$6 was based on the fee structure imposed by Alameda County to recover credit card processing fees. However, such an approach has the potential to lead to confusion and may require increased customized programming of software systems to accommodate multiple rates.

2. Residential Parking Permit Fee (Pages 9-10)

Question: What is the cost of this program? If this issue is under review by the Finance and Management Committee, should fee adjustment be delayed until review is complete?

Item:_____ Special ORA/City Council June 14, 2007 Response: On June 12, 2007, the Finance and Management Committee will hear a report from the Finance and Management Agency on a proposed increase in parking fines. At the Committee's direction, that report also includes a discussion of staff's recommendation to increase parking permit fees. The report includes a cost analysis of the Residential Permit Parking Program based upon RFPs issued in FY 2005-06, and the projection for FY 2007-08, assuming implementation of the proposed parking permit fee increase.

Staff recommends that the fee adjustment proceed. However, based upon the outcome of the discussion at the June 12th Finance and Management Committee meeting, action on this item may be deferred to a later date.

Police Services Agency

1. Dog License Fees (Page 11)

Question: What percentage of dogs in Oakland are licensed?

Response: It is estimated that 72,000 dogs live in our community based upon a formula provided by the Human Society. Of the 72,000 dogs, 9,500 or 13 percent are currently licensed.

2. Dog License Fees (Page 11)

Question: Are fees too high and a disincentive to encourage licensing? Propose ways to increase the percentage of dogs licensed in the city rather than raising the Dog License Fee.

Response: Some of the licensing fees have actually been lowered because it was found that people who license their dogs rarely have their dogs end up at the shelter and tend to be more responsible pet owners. Discounts are offered for pet owners willing to license for multiple years rather than year to year. Fees for unaltered dogs were increased because these animal owners contribute to animal overpopulation and contribute to a major increase in shelter population and shelter costs. The dog license fee increase was recommended based on what it costs to care for unlicensed dogs in the community. Prior to calculating the fee, staff met with animal shelter directors from throughout the Bay Area and learned that reducing fees has not resulted in an increase in licensed dogs. In some jurisdictions, increasing fees followed by advertising an amnesty program has resulted in an increase in licensed animals. Issuing a greater number of citations (it is a fix it ticket) has also resulted in an increase in licensing and brought people into the shelter where they receive information on the benefits of spay/neuter. Programs similar to this are currently being considered.

3. Dog License Fees (Page 11)

Question: How is the penalty for failure to renew a dog license within 60 days an incentive? Response: The penalty is designed to create an incentive to comply with the law. A grace period of 60 days gives citizens who just forgot or did not have time to comply sufficient time to take care of the licensing issue. The current fee structure provides little incentive to license the dog in a timely manner. The concept is similar to registering a vehicle or paying a parking fine - the longer you put it off, the higher the fee.

4. Dog License Fees (Page 11)

Question: Explain Fee Q for claiming an impounded animal.

Response: Fee Q is a redemption fee for claiming an impounded animal. The City incurs a financial burden when impounding an animal. Examples of impounded animals include: a dog left in a vehicle, a dog left unattended in a back yard while the owner is on vacation, dogs in a home where the occupants were arrested and stray dogs found wondering the streets. The fee covers the estimated average amount of time required to impound an animal and cost to provide required services. The impound procedure includes a basic medical examination and a temperament test. Most impounded dogs are not licensed and have no tag indicating that they have been vaccinated. For this reason, almost all impounded dogs must be vaccinated. The costs of these services as well as the cost of daily feeding and cleaning the dogs are passed on to the animal's owner. Animals that are impounded multiple times have an increased financial burden on the City. Fees associated with dogs impounded multiple times include the cost of home and yard inspections, and in some cases, the costs associated with the delivery of the dog to an alternate facility.

5. Taxicab Permit Fees (Page 12)

Question: Substantiate Taxicab Missed Appointment and Re-inspection Fees.

Response: This fee was removed from the Master Fee Schedule several years ago. Since that time, there has been an increase in the number of drivers missing their scheduled appointments which then causes conflict when their vehicles are taken out of service for safety violations. Re-instating these fees should provide incentive for the taxicab drivers to show up on time, maintain the safety of the vehicles and reduce the amount of Police Department resources required for enforcement. The \$90 Missed Appointment Fee will cover the cost of an Officer's 45 to 60 minute waiting time for missed appointments. The \$140 Re-inspection Fee will offset the cost of an Officer's 60 to 90 minute time to re-inspect a taxicab.

Fire Services Agency

1. Bowling Pin or Alley Refinishing Fee (Page 15)

Question: Is this fee relevant (there are no bowling alleys in Oakland)?

Response: The fee for "Bowling Pin or Alley Refinishing" has historically been included in the Master Fee Schedule. Although there are no bowling alleys in Oakland at this time, the fee will be in place should a bowling alley open at some time in the future.

2. Inspection Fee for Fire Clearance Certificate (Pages 18,19)

Question: Is fee pro-rated on an hourly basis?

Response: Yes, as with other Fire Services Agency fees, applicants will only be charged for the actual time of the inspection.

Office of Parks and Recreation

1. Children's Fairyland Admission (Page 33)

Question: Can this increase be limited to non-Oakland school children?

Response: Children's Fairyland has scholarships and transportation grant funds available for schools and nonprofits (including registered mom's groups) such that anyone with a financial need can attend Children's Fairyland free of charge. The fee has not been increased in the last six years.

2. Park Use Permits – Picnic Table Reservation (Pages 33-34)

Question: What is justification for cost increase from \$10 to \$50?

Response: OPR has re-evaluated this fee based upon Council feedback. Currently, park patrons are charged a park use permit fee. OPR proposes that the park use permit fee for groups of less than 50 patrons (\$50) be applied to any regular park use, including picnics without an additional picnic table fee. The Master Fee Schedule has been amended to reflect this change.

3. Park Use Permits (Pages 33-34)

Question: Provide explanation of difference between Regular and Special Events Response: The main difference between a Regular Event and a Special Event is that a Regular Event is a private event such as a family reunion, birthday party, etc. A Special Event is usually a public event such as a concert, an organized walk, a rally, etc. Rates for both types of events are based on the number of patrons participating.

4. Malonga Casquelourd Center – Studio A Rental Fee (Pages 41-42)

Question: What is justification for significant increase?

Response: Fees for Malonga Casquelourd Center studios have not been increased in a number of years and are far below both the competitive market rate and cost recovery calculations. The new rates are still below market, but more competitive and represent a City subsidy of approximately 33% of costs.

5. New Fees for Rental of Facilities/Equipment (Pages 43-46)

Question: Are we pricing ourselves out of the market?

Response: No. The proposed increases in facility rental rates are still well within the market rates for similar facilities. Assessment of market rates were based on OPR research of five other local municipalities (Berkeley, Albany, El Cerrito, Alameda, and San Leandro) as well as some private rental facilities in Oakland.

6. Sailing Into Science (Page 47)

Question: Why has basis of fee calculation changed? (from per person to per class)

Response: The proposed change to the fee structure is to make billing and payment tracking more efficient. The actual cost to the Oakland Unified School District hasn't changed and is designed to simply cover program costs. Subsidies are available for Title I schools or others if the fees are an obstacle to participation.

7. Chabot Golf Course Fees (Page 48)

Question: Are fees cost covering or is City subsidizing costs?

Response: Lake Chabot Golf fees cover operating costs. There is no City subsidy for Lake Chabot operations. The lower fees proposed are for "Super Twilight" rates to encourage more golfers to use the course during traditionally low use times and have no impact on regular play fees.

8. Metropolitan Golf Fees (Pages 49-50)

Question: Why are fees 'without cart' based on 'per cart'?

Response. The "without cart" fees should be listed with a "per person" unit. The Master Fee Schedule has been adjusted accordingly.

Community and Economic Development Agency

1. Pushcart Food Vending (Page 59)

Question: Is this program self sustaining? Are we covering our cost at the current fee rate or are we required to subsidize this program?

Response: For the three quarters of FY 06-07, the revenues collected for the pushcart food vending ordinance have not kept pace with the funding necessary to successfully support the program. Specifically, the budget includes a \$68,000 appropriation for this purpose, which funds approximately a half time code enforcement position. Only \$35,000 has been collected to date. Thus, the City is subsidizing the program as we are not covering our cost at the current rate of collection. Presently, we are not monitoring this type of activity proactively but on a complaint basis only.

If the Council wishes to increase the staff time required for enforcement of this program, the fees must be approximately doubled. In addition, if the Council wishes to provide additional enforcement staff for this purpose, additional fees may be required to support it. The annual cost to support a full time enforcement position for this effort would be approximately \$120,000 and would require that annual fees be significantly increased to approximately \$800. At this level, the Council could expect a quicker response and an area by area monitoring of pushcart food vending activities.

2. Residential Loan Servicing Late Fee (Page 83)

Question: What is the rationale for this increase especially since these loans are targeted towards low and moderate income households?

Response: Currently, a third party bank administers our existing amortized loans and charges a 6% late penalty fees where payments are received after the 15th of the month. However, we no longer administer amortized loans since our amortized loan program was discontinued in February 2006. Currently, out of an existing portfolio of roughly 2000 loans, roughly 4% (approx. 80) are amortized and continually reach maturity every year. So in effect, these fees are imposed both in an effort to recoup costs in addition to late payments. This fee has been waived in the past when the applicant requests a waiver and can demonstrate an extreme financial hardship.

3. Applications under Oakland Zoning Regulations: Small Project Design Review (Page 85) *Question:* What is the justification for deleting the Special Residential Design Review and introducing the Small Project Design Review fees?

Response: Council passed a resolution effective April 1, 2007 to eliminate the Special Residential Design Review and introduced the small project design review fees (Ordinance No. 12776 C.M.S.). The fees were consolidated to offer a more simple structure. In addition, some of the appeal fees increased to account for staff time. The design review ordinance contains a significant public outreach requirement, including meetings with neighbors, thereby minimizing appeals.

 The proposed fee adjustments have been revised to be more consistent with rates for other similar facilities.
- 3. Metropolitan Golf Fees (Pages 49-50)

The fee for players 'without carts' has been revised to a 'per person' fee rather than a 'per cart' fee.
