A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE MEASURE Y COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMS INCLUDING CITY-COUNTY NEIGHBORHOOD INITIATIVE (CCNI), MESSENGERS4CHANGE AND THE LATE NIGHT LIVE IN THE PARKS PROJECT UTILIZING TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) IN MEASURE Y, THE VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND PUBLIC SAFETY ACT OF 2004 FUNDS FROM JULY 1, 2012 – JUNE 30, 2015

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland voters passed Measure Y, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004, in November 2004, approving a series of taxes to support violence prevention objectives, programs and services to reduce violence among children, youth and young adults in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the violent crime rate in Oakland is considerably higher than that of other large cities in California; and

WHEREAS, community engagement activities are a vital component of implementing violence prevention programs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate \$186,000 of Measure Y, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 funds, to the City of Oakland, City Administrator's Office of Neighborhood Services to support 2 FTE Community Building Coordinators, one for East Oakland and one for West Oakland and supplies for the City-County Neighborhood Initiative program for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015 into Fund (2251), Organization (02111) and Project Code to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorizing to appropriate \$54,000 of Measure Y, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 funds as a match to a United States Department of Justice grant, to support 1 FTE Community Engagement Coordinator at the City of Oakland, Department of Human Services and supplies to implement the Messengers4Change program, for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015 into the Department of Human Services Fund (2251), DHS Administration Organization (78311), and a project to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorizing to appropriate \$10,000 of Measure Y funds, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act to the City Administrator's Office to support the Late Night Live in the Parks program for two park programs each summer for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015 into Fund (2251), Organization (02111) and Project Code to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, memoranda of understanding, amendments, modifications, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary in accordance with its basic purpose; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreement shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


