RESOLUTION No. 81124 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION RENAMING SOUTH COLISEUM WAY BETWEEN 66th AVENUE AND HEGENBERGER ROAD AS JOE MORGAN WAY

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 34091.1 allows a jurisdiction, by resolution, to name a new public street or to rename an existing public street; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 77967 C.M.S., the honorable Larry Reid, current member of the Council of the City of Oakland representing District 7, and the honorable Ignacio De La Fuente, current member of the Council of the City of Oakland representing District 5, did request that the City Council rename South Coliseum Way, between its intersections with 66th Avenue and Hegenberger Road, in honor of Joe Morgan, a member of the Major League Baseball Hall of Fame and the founder of the Joe Morgan Youth Foundation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 80902 C.M.S., the Council of the City of Oakland did proclaim November 12, 2007, as "Joe Morgan Day" in honor of Joe Morgan's four (4) decades of personal service and financial generosity to the youth of the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said request by the honorable Councilmembers, the City Engineer of the City of Oakland did notify, through United States mail with regular postage, the two (2) owners of the three (3) privately owned and commercially zoned parcels along South Coliseum Way, as further identified in Exhibit A attached hereto, of said request for a street commemoration to honor Joe Morgan; and

WHEREAS, said property owners were advised in said notice from the City Engineer that the City Council could, at its option, approve the renaming of South Coliseum Way or, as an alternative, retain the South Coliseum Way name and approve the installation of a commemorative plaque or signs to honor Joe Morgan; and

WHEREAS, said property owners were provided a ballot in said notice on which they could indicate their preference for either option or both options; and

WHEREAS, said property owners were also advised in said notice that said ballot should be returned to the City Engineer within one month of its mailing; and

WHEREAS, said property owners were also advised in said notice that the City Engineer would consider the failure of property owners to return their ballots within the allotted time to be a vote in favor of renaming South Coliseum Way to honor Joe Morgan; and

WHEREAS, said property owners were provided a return envelope, with pre-paid postage affixed

thereto, addressed to the City Engineer to mail their marked ballot; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer received no ballots from said property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer subsequently notified said property owners, through United States mail with regular postage, of the location and date and time that the City Council would publicly meet to receive testimony from the public and vote either to reject the street commemoration or to rename South Coliseum Way to honor Joe Morgan, or to retain the South Coliseum Way name and authorize the installation of a commemorative plaque or signs; and

WHEREAS, on said date and at said time and location for a public meeting, the Council of the City of Oakland did meet and did receive public testimony and did deliberate on the provisions set forth in Resolution No. 77967 C.M.S. for evaluation of street commemorations; and

WHEREAS, the naming of a new public street or the renaming of an existing public street is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Council of the City of Oakland hereby approves the renaming of South Coliseum Way, between its intersections with 66th Avenue and Hegenberger Road, in honor of Joe Morgan; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That expenditure appropriation of \$3,382 be transferred from the General Purpose Fund (1010), CIP City Manager Org (94020), PayGo District 5 and District 7 project (B01140), to the General Purpose Fund (1010), Engineering Services Org (88432); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Public Works Agency is directed to manufacture and install new street signs displaying the name Joe Morgan Way; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That pursuant to California Government Code Section 34092, the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors.



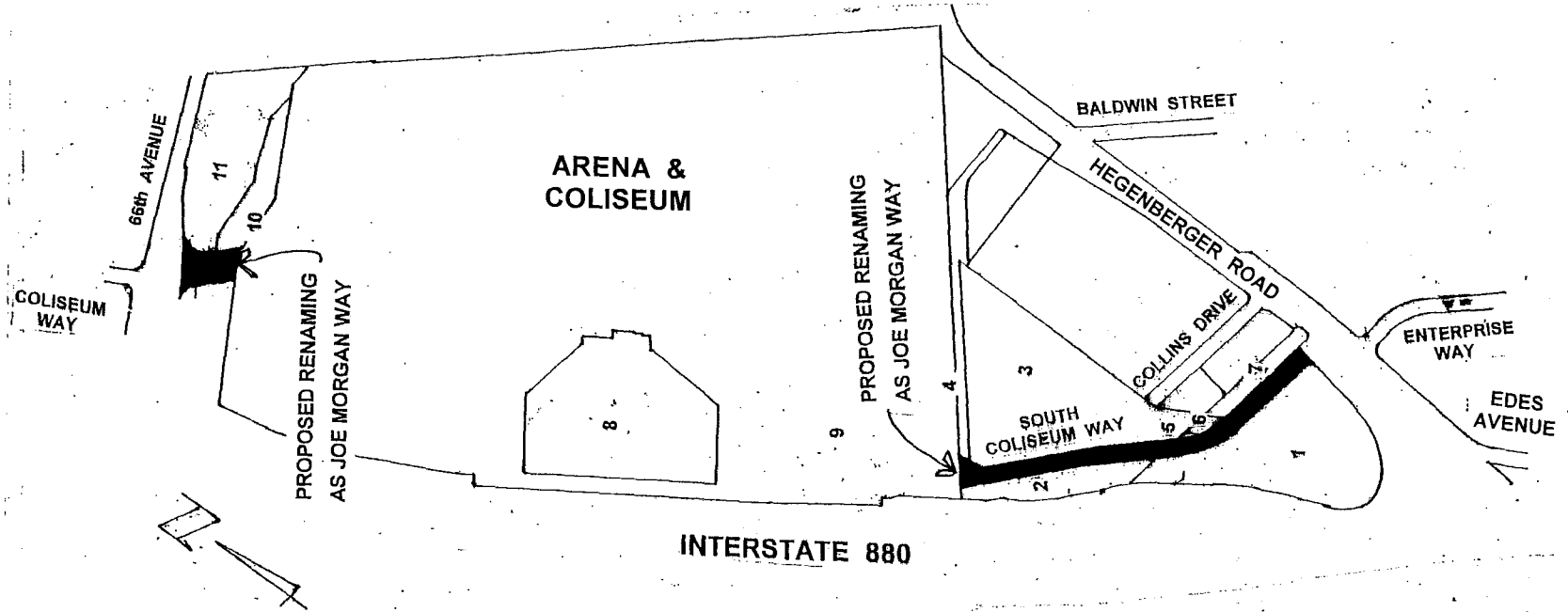
