What is the fiscal impact on the City/Agency? The professional services agreement with DKS Associates will be for an amount not to exceed \$103,140. This amount includes a contingency in the amount of \$13,450, which is 15 percent. Funding to cover this cost is available from the Municipal Improvement Capital Fund (5500), Capital Improvement Projects - Transportation Services Organization (92246), and Citywide Pedestrian Safety Program (C188510).
