EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On May 31, 2021, The Oakland City Council Approved Resolution Number 88607 C.M.S., Which Prioritized The Recommendations From The Reimagining Public Safety Task Force Within The 2021-23 Fiscal Budget. This Resolution Aims To "[E]Xplore The Possible Transfer, No Earlier Than July 2022, Of The Majority Of The Internal Affairs Division From The Oakland Police Department (OPD) To The Community Police Review Agency (CPRA)."

On May 22, 2025, Councilmember Fife Requested That An Informational Report Be Heard By The Public Safety Committee Regarding The Civilianization Of Sworn Positions In OPD. The Accompanying Report (*Attachment A*) From The Director Of The CPRA Addresses This Request.
