RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENTS OF MARCUS GUILLARD AND MARIO NAVASERO AS MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ART ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 11086 C.M.S., amended by Ordinance No. 13562 C.M.S., establishes the Public Art Advisory Committee as a professionally qualified citizen committee responsible for advising the City regarding its public art program; and

WHEREAS, the Public Art Advisory Committee consists of nine members serving threeyear terms with no more than two consecutive terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Sheng Thao has appointed Marcus Guillard and Mario Navasero to serve three-year terms on the Public Art Advisory Committee subject to confirmation of the City Council; now, therefore, be it
