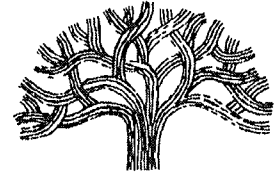

My interest focused on the environment and how it affects low income communities. Bicycling became an important part of this experience, it provided clean affordable transportation.

- La Clinica that was providing much needed affordable healthcare and I was interested in creating much needed logistics systems. This gave me the opportunity to continue my informal education as a manager. The clinic was getting started with just under 200 staff in Oakland. The clinics are now in 3 counties in underserved areas, with over 1000 employees and the Materials Management team, takes care of the whole supply chain, official forms, publications and managing our Intranet adding new tools to help staff and project management.
- I enjoy the challenge of pulling systems together. I am comfortable with Excel and Word. I can work with programmers to create what is needed to maintain a supply chain. I have worked with our emergency preparedness team internally and participated in statewide drills. 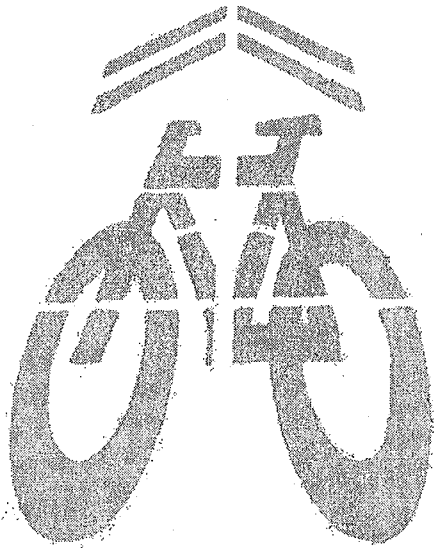

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S REAPPOINTMENT OF ROSA VILLALOBOS AND CHRISTOPHER KIDD TO THE BICYCLIST AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be re-appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 18815 C.M.S., adopted February 4, 2014, created the Oakland Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission to advise City Council and staff on bicyclist- and pedestrian- specific policies, projects, and programs, and on the accommodation of bicyclists and pedestrians in all transportation plans, policies, projects and programs, and to provide annual reports to the Public Works Committee of the City Council, to summarize the Commission's work over the course of the year, and to identify key policy issues affecting the safety of and access for bicyclists and pedestrians in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission consists of nine members serving three-year staggered terms with no more than six consecutive years of service by any Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has re-appointed Rosa Villalobos and Christopher Kidd to each serve on the Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: that pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's re-appointment of:

Rosa Villalobos to serve a three-year term on the Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2019, filling the seat previously held by herself.
