**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON  
4TH<sup>TH</sup> STREET AT WEBSTER STREET**

**WHEREAS**, Jack London District residents and the Police Department have requested the Transportation Services Division to investigate traffic safety, specifically pedestrian safety, at the intersection of 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Webster Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Transportation Services Division staff investigated the site conditions and the accident history of this intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, OMC Section 10.12.110 authorizes the Transportation Services Manager, by Council resolution, to install stop signs at intersections or railroad crossings based on engineering standards and practices; and

**WHEREAS**, funds totaling \$1,000.00 are available to implement the stop signs and associated pavement markings in the Measure B Fund (2211), Transportation Services Organization (30262), Neighborhood Traffic Safety Program Project (C268510); now, therefore, be it
