RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING (1) THE ALLOCATION TO THE AFRICAN AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OF \$9,050 OF THE \$15,000 OF VICE MAYOR LARRY E. REID'S PRIORITY FUNDS THAT THE COUNCIL PREVIOUSLY APPROVED FOR THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA COMPASSION NETWORK BY RESOLUTION NO. 80434 AND (2) AN ADDITIONAL \$950 FROM VICE MAYOR REID'S PRIORITY FUNDS FOR A TOTAL GRANT OF \$10,000; AND AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF RESOLUTION 80434 WHICH ALLOCATED \$15,000 TO THE NETWORK TO PROVIDE A GRANT OF \$5,950 TO THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA COMPASSION NETWORK

WHEREAS, On June 8, 2006 the City Council did amend the 2005-2007 Policy Budget for the City of Oakland to include \$250,000 a piece for the Mayor and each councilmember to use as priority funds for projects in the City of Oakland or in councilmembers' districts subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 80434 approved by Council on March 6, 2007 granted \$15,000 from Vice Mayor Reid's priority funds to the Northern California Compassion Network for equipment for their warehouse and \$5,950 was expended for the purchase of a forklift; and

WHEREAS, the Northern California Compassion Network has relocated to a new warehouse which includes equipment that was needed at their old location, Vice Mayor Reid wishes to reprogram \$9,050 of the \$15,000 allocated to the Network to the African-American Chamber of Commerce for operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, Vice Mayor Larry E. Reid wishes to grant an additional \$950 of his priority project funds to the African-American Chamber of Commerce for a total grant of \$10,000 to be used for operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, The City will require African-American Chamber of Commerce to provide documentation for use of the Councilmember's priority project funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the grant of \$10,000 from Vice Mayor Larry E. Reid's priority project funds to the African-American Chamber of Commerce; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to execute an appropriate grant agreement with the African-American Chamber of Commerce with the purposes of the grant, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.; and be it
