RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO CLAIM, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FY 2002-03 STATE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) ARTICLE 3 FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 TO UNDERWRITE THE FIRST STATEWIDE CONFERENCE ON WALKING AND BICYCLING

WHEREAS, Article 3 of the Transportation Development Act (TDA), Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 99200 et seq., authorizes the submission of claims to a regional transportation planning agency for the funding of projects exclusively for the benefit and/or use of pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), as the regional transportation planning agency for the San Francisco Bay region, has adopted MTC Resolution No. 875, Revised, entitled "Transportation Development Act, Article 3, Pedestrian/Bicycle Projects," which delineates procedures and criteria for submission of requests for the allocation of "TDA Article 3" funding; and

WHEREAS, MTC Resolution No. 875, Revised requires that requests for the allocation of TDA Article 3 funding be submitted as part of a single, countywide coordinated claim from each county in the San Francisco Bay region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland desires to apply for \$30,000 in FY 2002-03 TDA Article 3 funds for the first Statewide Conference on Walking and Bicycling -- an educational project which is for the exclusive benefit and/or use of pedestrians and/or bicyclists -- to be held in downtown Oakland; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland declares it is eligible to request an allocation of TDA Article 3 funds pursuant to Section 99234 of the Public Utilities Code; and be it further

RESOLVED: That a certified copy of this resolution and its attachments, and any accompanying supporting materials shall be forwarded to the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency for submission to MTC as part of the countywide coordinated TDA Article 3 claim; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the application, acceptance and appropriation of FY 2002-03 TDA Article 3 allocation of \$30,000 to underwrite the first Statewide Conference on Walking and Bicycling, to be held in downtown Oakland; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute and submit all documents, payment requests and related actions, as well as to appropriate any additional grant funds received for the completion of the aforementioned project; and be it further

RESOLVED: That should additional funds be received for the conference, the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate the same for the purposes described above.
