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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AMENDED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE COUNTY OF ALAMEDA TO CLARIFY THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE APPLICATION AND USE OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA HOMELESS HOUSING, ASSISTANCE, AND PREVENTION (HHAP) ROUND 6 FUNDING

WHEREAS, State of California Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention (HHAP) funds are integral to the City of Oakland's homeless intervention system to maintain existing emergency homeless interventions; and

WHEREAS, since Round 5 of HHAP funds, the State of California has required the City of Oakland (City) and County of Alameda (County) to collaborate on more aggressive goals toward ending homelessness requiring repurposing of funds toward additional exit resources, including entering into a Memorandum of Understanding that will address the jurisdictions' joint response to homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 89777 C.M.S., authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding to clarify the roles and responsibilities of the City and County in the application for and use of HHAP Round 5 funds; and

WHEREAS, effective as of February 1, 2024, the City and County executed a Memorandum of Understanding for the application and use of HHAP Round 5 funds, which was then amended by a First Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator now desires to amend the existing Memorandum of Understanding to clarify the roles and responsibilities under HHAP Round 6; and therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into one or more amendments to the existing Memorandum of Understanding between the City and County, dated as of February 1, 2024, in order to satisfy application requirements for HHAP Round 6 or any future rounds of HHAP funding or other regionally-allocated funding to address the shelter crisis; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all agreements and further amendments authorized by this Resolution shall be reviewed and approved by the Office of the City Attorney for form and legality.
