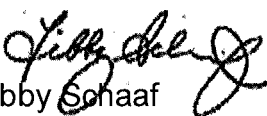

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR LIBBY SCHAAF

**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF
AYUSHI ROY AS A MEMBER OF THE LIBRARY ADVISORY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 8064 C.M.S, adopted November 13, 1969 and amended by Ordinance Nos. 11730 C.M.S., 12879 C.M.S, 13174 C.M.S., and 13560 C.M.S., establishes the Library Advisory Commission to advise and make recommendations on the operation and future development of the library system and to act as a liaison between the Library Department and the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Library Advisory Commission consists of fifteen (15) members serving not more than two consecutive three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed Ayushi Roy to serve a three-year term subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Ayushi Roy to the Library Advisory Commission to serve the term beginning November 17, 2018 and ending November 16, 2021, filling the seat previously held by Amy Johnson.
