## OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION No. 88111 C.M.S.

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE FEDERAL CHILD AND ADULT CARE FOOD PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$249,723, AND ANY SUCH ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR NUTRITIOUS MEALS FOR THE HEAD START/EARLY HEAD START PROGRAM FROM JULY 1, 2020 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2021**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland (City) desires to apply for and accept a U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) Grant in an estimated amount of \$249,723 from the California Department of Education (CDE) Child Nutrition Services Division to fund a Head Start/Early Head Start child nutrition program from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-2021 Midcycle Proposed Budget includes \$249,723 in appropriations in the Department of Agriculture Fund (2102), HS Classroom and Seasonal Org (78231), Head Start FY20-21 CCFP Project (1004507), Strengthening Children, Youth & Families Program (YS13) for FY 2020-21 for the CACFP grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the CDE Child Nutrition and Distribution Division will provide funds for comprehensive nutrition services to approximately 300 enrolled in the City's Head Start and Early Head Start children, who have the most economic need, with ten percent of the enrollment consisting of children with special needs; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City, by and through the City Administrator or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit an application to the CDE for, and the City hereby accepts and appropriates, USDA CACFP funds in an estimated amount of \$249,723 to operate a Child Care Food Program for children enrolled in the Oakland Head Start and Early Head Start program from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City hereby accepts and appropriates any additional funding that may become available from this grantor (i.e., USDA), for the same purposes (i.e., CACFP), within the existing grant term, July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021, without returning to Council; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, and to take all related actions which may be necessary to apply for, accept and appropriate the aforementioned grants; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That any agreements and amendments authorized under this resolution shall be reviewed as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and copies filed with the Office of the City Clerk.


