

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, FY 2009 LAW ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING GRANT PROGRAM FOR CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION AND OPERATION OF THE EAST BAY TASK FORCE ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 will be awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, FY 2009 Law Enforcement Response to Human Trafficking grant program for the continued implementation and operation of the East Bay Task Force on Human Trafficking in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the proposed program term is October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 80893 C.M.S., dated October 16, 2007, Resolution No. 79275 C.M.S., dated June 7, 2005; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice, and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That grant funds shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund (2112), Youth and Family Services Division Org. (102350), Youth and Family Services Division Program (PS03), in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, as agent of the City, to conduct all negotiations and related actions and to sign all applications and agreements that may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grant.
