

RESOLUTION NO. _____ C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH INSIGHT GLOBAL, FOR TEMPORARY AS NEEDED TECHNICAL STAFF AUGMENTATION IN THE GRAND TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$3,750,000 FOR A TERM BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2024, AND ENDING JULY 31, 2029, AND TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY, WAIVING THE LOCAL/SMALL LOCAL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, technology, including both systems and data, is the underlying pin that connects multiple City departments and agencies together and remains the basis upon which many City of Oakland processes provide services to its constituents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Department of Information Technology has the occasional need for urgent and temporary IT technical expertise and assistance to support critical projects and platforms spanning enterprise and public safety applications; and

WHEREAS, the City has a vested interest in the functionality of these systems and platforms that sporadically require specialized functional support and staff augmentation including, but not limited to programming, troubleshooting, database and network administration and management, and specialized program design integration for enterprise systems including public safety; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code (“OMC”) section 2.04.080 [Cooperate Agreement Purchasing] authorizes the use of agreements of “...other governmental jurisdictions or public agencies that were awardee pursuant to an appropriate competitive process”; and

WHEREAS, the cooperative purchase is recommended to be made through University of California, CA Contract Number 2021003051; and

WHEREAS, the Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (L/SLBE) Program, Ordinance No. 13647 C.M.S., requires a minimum fifty-percent (50%) participation for all professional service contracts valued at or over fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) when there are at least three certified businesses listed in the industry, trade, or profession that constitutes a major category of work; and if at least three L/SLBEs are not certified, then the requirement is either waived, or the 50%

requirement may be set at a percentage from 50 % to 0%, but not less than 20% if at least one L/SLBE is certified and available; and

WHEREAS, the Council may, in its discretion, waive the requirements of the L/SLBE Program; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that it is in the best interest of the City to waive the L/SLBE requirements as the specialized nature of these temporary assignments required contractors trained in the enterprise systems utilized by the City through a vendor uniquely qualified to provide technical management support to large entities the size of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the funding for any temporary assignment made under this agreement would be drawn from funds already appropriated and allocated to the Information Technology Department through the City Council budgeting process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that this agreement is for temporary services of a technical, scientific or professional nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further finds that this agreement shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council finds and determines the forgoing recitals to be true and correct and hereby adopts and incorporates them into this Resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Administrator or designee is authorized without returning to Council to negotiate and execute an agreement with Insight Global for temporary assignments providing technical support to specialized Information Technology projects and platforms in an amount not to exceed \$3,750,000 for a term beginning August 1, 2024 and ending July 31, 2029; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that for the reasons stated above and, in the report, accompanying this Resolution, the City Council hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the City to waive the City's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise program requirements, and so waives these requirements for the information technology agreements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that this on-call contract complies with Oakland Municipal Code ("OMC") section 2.04.080 [Cooperate Agreement Purchasing] which authorizes the use of agreements of "...other governmental jurisdictions or public agencies that were awardee pursuant to an appropriate competitive process"; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: the cooperative purchase is recommended to be made through University of California, CA Contract Number 2021003051; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to approve and execute any subsequent amendments or extensions of said contract, with the exception of those related

to an increase in total compensation; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the agreement and any subsequent amendments under this resolution shall be reviewed and approved by the Office of the City Attorney for form and legality prior to execution and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
