RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GIFT OF A CITY OF OAKLAND POLICE CALL BOX AND PEDESTAL TO CHIEF OF POLICE RICHARD L. WORD IN RECOGNITION OF HIS 20 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE CITY OF OAKLAND IN ACCORD WITH ARTICLE 206 OF THE CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has recognized Richard L. Word for his 20 years of service; and

WHEREAS, Oakland City Charter Section 206 authorizes the City Council to set compensation for City employees, including retirement benefits, gifts, and other such compensation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to provide Chief Word a special remembrance of his service ; and

WHEREAS, The City of Oakland retired its Police Call Box system in 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Police Call Boxes are no longer in use and considered surplus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Police Call Boxes served the men and women of Oakland Police department for over 100 years; and

WHEREAS, this Call Box will serve as a fond memory to Chief Word of his service to the Citizen's of Oakland; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby authorizes the City to provide Chief Richard L. Word, a City of Oakland Police Call Box and pedestal in recognition of his exemplary service to the City of Oakland and its citizens.
