(Master Fee Schedule), As Amended, To Establish, Modify And Delete Fees Assessed By The Oakland Public Library, Community And Economic Development Agency, Department Of Human Services, The Oakland Police Department And The Parking Operations Division Of The Finance And

Management Agency

SUMMARY

The attached Ordinance provides amendments to Ordinance No. 12880 C.M.S. (the FY 2008-09 Master Fee Schedule, or "MFS"), in addition to those proposed to the City Council on May 13, 2009. This ordinance includes omitted changes, as originally submitted, to establish, modify and delete fees and penalties assessed by the following agencies or departments: the Oakland Public Library, Community and Economic Development Agency, the Department of Human Services, the Oakland Police Department and the Parking Operations Division of the Finance and Management Agency.

FISCAL IMPACT

The revenue from the proposed changes in fees will produce an estimated \$4.67 million for the General Purpose Fund. Of this amount, the \$3.5 million from the parking meter rate increases are <u>not</u> already reflected in the printed FY 2009-11 Proposed Budget. Staff recommends that the additional anticipated revenue will be used to decrease the recommended suspended payments to the Internal Service Funds. This recommended change will be presented as a "technical adjustment" in the June 16, 2009 report on the FY 2009-11 budget.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The Master Fee Schedule changes are summarized below, along with justifications and estimated revenue changes.

1. Oakland Public Library

• The Oakland Public Library is proposing new fees to use the Tool Lending Library: An annual fee for unlimited use (\$35 per year) and a one-time use fee (\$10 per item).

2. Department of Human Services

• The Department of Human Services is submitting a fee increase to the Multipurpose Senior Centers category for Mandatory Set-Up and Take-Down, from \$125 per event to \$150 per event. An increase in revenues is not anticipated.

3. Community and Economic Development Agency

• The Community and Economic Development Agency's prior submission omitted a fee change to the Miscellaneous category within the Jobs/Housing fee. The increase, from \$4.56 per square foot to \$4.70 per square foot, is not anticipated to generate additional revenues.

4. Oakland Police Department

- 5. The Oakland Police Department (OPD) is submitting changes to their Master Fee Schedule. The revenues anticipated as a result of the fee changes is estimated at \$1.17 million. All revenues are anticipated to accrue to the General Purpose Fund. For details on the proposed changes, please refer to Exhibit A of the ordinance.
 - a. The following fee increases (ranging from a 12 percent increase to a 50 percent increase) are proposed:
 - i. Dog license for dogs belonging to seniors as required by Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) section 6.04.030;
 - ii. Reports- screened traffic accident reports;
 - iii. Photographs- color photographs of various sizes;
 - iv. Redemption fee for claiming an impounded animal as required by OMC section 6.04.220;
 - v. Identification service fee- license and permit fingerprints rolling fee (residents; fingerprint card with corpus check; corpus only; clearance letter, license and permit fingerprint rolling fee (non-resident)
 - vi. Vehicle releases- administrative fee authorized by vehicle code for towing/impounding, and releasing vehicles towed/impounded.
 - vii. Special Traffic Offender Program Vehicle Release.
 - b. The Department is proposing to delete fees they will no longer collect:
 - i. Photographs 11"x14" and 16"x20"
 - ii. Taxi Cab permit fees
 - iii. False alarm program fees

c. OPD is proposing new fees for claiming impounded livestock as required by the OMC section 6.04.220, animal shelter inspections, and for special events.

6. Parking Operations Division, Finance and Management Agency

- Staff has presented a series of parking-related revenue changes to the June 9th Finance and Management Committee. The revenues anticipated as a result of the fee changes is estimated at \$3.5 million. All revenues are anticipated to accrue to the General Purpose Fund. For details on the proposed changes, please refer to Exhibit A of the ordinance.
 - a. The following fee increases are proposed:
 - i. Increase the current parking meter per hour rate of \$1.50 by 25 cents citywide. The anticipated annual increase would be \$1.2 million.
 - ii. Increase hourly meter rates to \$3.00 per hour between the hours of 10:00 am and 2:00 pm to reflect "high-demand" usage. This rate increase would yield \$2.3 million in additional revenue.

ACTION REQUESTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council accept this report and adopt the proposed ordinance amending the Master Fee Schedule, as detailed in Exhibit A. Once adopted, the amended fees will become effective on July 1, 2009.
