RESOLUTION NO. 76160 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO ACCEPT TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$238,998) IN CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT PROGRAM (CLEEP) GRANT FUNDS AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the State of California has made funds available through its California Law Enforcement Equipment Program (CLEEP) to enhance local law enforcement technology; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has selected the Oakland Police Department to receive \$238,998 to fund new and upgraded technology;

WHEREAS, the Department would not otherwise be able to purchase this equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Department will use the grant funds to upgrade support systems for the Department's budget and accounting and duplicating functions; and

WHEREAS, the new and upgraded technology will enhance the Department's ability to serve frontline officers and prepare training and information materials; and

WHEREAS, there are no matching funds required for this grant; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to accept \$238,998 in grant funds from the State of California CLEEP program and appropriate said funds to a Police Department project under a new State grant fund number; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his designee is further authorized to execute all agreements and other documents necessary in connection with the grant.
