**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL SB 1218 (ARREGUÍN) TO
AMEND THE CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE TO REQUIRE PAYMENT
OR RESOLUTION OF ILLEGAL DUMPING FINES BEFORE VEHICLE
REGISTRATION CAN BE COMPLETED**

WHEREAS, illegal dumping is a serious violation that damages our community, our economy, and our public health; and

WHEREAS, abandoned waste attracts additional dumping, creates fire hazards, blocks sidewalks, harms local businesses, and disproportionately impacts low income and communities of color; and

WHEREAS, Oakland sees roughly 25,000 request for service related to illegal dumping per year¹; and

WHEREAS, Oakland has seen the number of requests for service for illegal dumping rise in each of the last three years; and

WHEREAS, Oakland has issued nearly 3,000 illegal dumping citations between 2021 and 2024 but has collected only roughly 11% of the fines issued²; and

WHEREAS, without predictable consequences for illegal dumping, individuals will likely continue to dump waste and debris; and

WHEREAS, Senator Jessie Arreguín has introduced Senate Bill (SB) 1218 to address the issue of illegal dumping; and

WHEREAS, SB 1218 would require payment or resolution of illegal dumping fines before California Department of Motor Vehicles registration can be completed; and

WHEREAS, the administrative framework for this enforcement mechanism would follow the same model that already exists for parking tickets; and

RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland endorses SB 1218 and urges the California State Legislature and Governor Gavin Newsom to support its enactment into law.


