RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$40,770) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, FOR THE 2008/2009 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GANG RESISTANCE EDUCATION AND TRAINING (GREAT) GRANT PROGRAM IN THE OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND APPROPRIATE SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in the amount of \$40,770 will be awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, for instruction of the Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT) program by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these federal grant funds are earmarked to provide gang resistance education to middle and elementary school students enrolled in Oakland Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, funding for the GREAT Grant Program will assist in the Police Department's goal of decreasing incidents of youth-based violence and other delinquent activities; and

WHEREAS, a local cash or in-kind match of no less than 10 percent (10%) of the total federal funds requested is required and must be made from local funds, and

WHEREAS, the Police Department requests authorization to use an in-kind match of \$8,675, which consists of the Oakland Police Activities League Director's labor hours (\$41.91/hr x 1.5 x 6 hrs/week x 23 weeks); now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to apply for, accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of \$40,770 to the Police Department from the Department of Justice for the implementation of the 2008/2009 Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT) program for the grant period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009;

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That grant funds shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund: 2112; Campus Life And School Safety (CLASS) Org.:102350; Youth and Family Services Program PS03; in a Project Number to be established; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council authorizes the Police Department's use of \$4,530 as in-kind matching funds, which consists of the Oakland Police Activities League Director's labor hours (\$41.91/hr x 1.5 x 6 hrs/week x 23 weeks), for the 2008/2009 GREAT Grant Program, the salary is paid from the General Purpose Fund: 1010; Youth and Family Services Program: 102350; Youth and Family Services Division: PS13; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That Central Services Overhead expenses in the amount of \$4,201 have been included and will be absorbed with the grant appropriations; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Attorney shall review and approve all agreements and/or contracts to form and legality, and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
