RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE ARGEEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND ("CITY") AND IPT LLC ("PAYLOCK"), EXTENDING AT NO COST TO THE CITY THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 6 MONTHS, STARTING OCTOBER 15, 2014 AND TERMINATING APRIL 14, 2015 TO PROVIDE SELF-RELEASE SMARTBOOT VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATON PROGRAM SERVICES; AND WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL/QUALIFICATIONS PROCESS.

WHEREAS, IPT LLC (herein "PayLock") provides a unique vehicle "boot" program that allows a motorist to unlock the vehicle immobilization device using a code provided over the phone upon payment of applicable fine and services charges; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 82200 C.M.S., the City Council waived the Request for Proposal/Qualifications Process and authorized entry into a sole-source service agreement at no cost to the City with PayLock, Inc. for a three-year term with two one-year options to extend the term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2009, the City entered an agreement with PayLock for Self-Release Smartboot Vehicle Immobilization Services and Associated Parking Ticket Collections, and exercised two contract renewals; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with PayLock expires on October 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS, City desires to maintain PayLock services for self-release Smartboot vehicle immobilization services and associated parking ticket collections; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services are professional, scientific or technical and the six-month extension is temporary and will not result in the loss of salary or employment by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the contract extension of the existing contract will be for a period not to exceed six months, starting October 15, 2014 and terminating April 14, 2015 for providing self-release Smartboot vehicle immobilization program services no cost to the City as authorized by City Council Resolution No. 82200; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code section 2.04.051.B and for the reasons set forth herein and in the accompanying staff report, the City Council finds and determines it is in the City's best interest to waive the request for proposal/qualifications process for the six-month extension; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to award a contract extension not to exceed 6 months, starting October 15, 2014 and terminating April 14, 2015.
