RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT \$189,467.62 OF FUNDS REIMBURSED FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, The Fire Department purchased four (4) Portable Above Ground Water Supply Systems funded from Measure I funds; and

WHEREAS, The State Office of Emergency Services, agreed to reimburse the Department \$189,467.62 for the cost of one of the Water Systems and the funds have been received fkom the State and deposited into the City's Treasury; and

WHEREAS, The Fire Department proposes to utilize these funds for other approved Measure I activities: to complete Fire Station seismic retrofitting, engineering design of a fire station and the purchase of emergency rescue and evacuation equipment; Now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to appropriate \$189,467.62 in funds received fkom the State Office of Emergency Services, to the Fire Department's operating budget for use with previously authorized Measure I activities.
