

RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING CESAR SAN MIGUEL, KYLE WILLIS, ANASTACIA LOVE, AND AILISH ELZY, AND APPOINTING NAOMI TURNER, EDWIN VILLEGAS, SABAH HARRIS, JUAN GOMEZ, ALEXANDRIA AMAMGBO, AFOLARIN ADELEKE, TAYLOR LYONS, ALEXANDRIA LOVE, JA'NEY BATISTE, TERRY MORGAN, ERIC GRANT, STEVEN WESLEY, MARCELLIOUS MCNARY, AND AMINA SCOTT AS MEMBERS OF THE OAKLAND YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 10545 C.M.S. creates the Youth Advisory Commission whose members are nominated by the Mayor and approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 11869 C.M.S. specifies that members of the Youth Advisory Commission are to serve a two year term, and appointments to fill a term of office are only to be for the remainder of that term; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that by the nomination of Mayor Ronald V. Dellums the following individuals are hereby appointed to the term set forth below:
