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RESOLUTION 1) AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXTEND THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CENTRO LEGAL **RAZA** DE LA **FOR PROVISION** REPRESENTATION SERVICES TO LOW- AND MODERATE-INCOME **TENANTS** \mathbf{AT} RENT **ADJUSTMENT PROGRAM** PROCEEDINGS FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM FROM OCTOBER 1, 2025 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000, RENEWABLE AT THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S OPTION FOR UP TO THREE ADDITIONAL YEARS FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000,000; AND (2) WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE RFP/Q AND SMALL LOCAL BUSINES ENTERPRISE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2023, staff released a Request for Proposals (RFP) for representation services of low- and moderate-income tenants at Rent Adjustment Program (RAP) petition proceedings and Housing, Residential Rent and Relocation Board (HRRRB) appeal proceedings (collectively, RAP Proceedings) pursuant to the City of Oakland's contracting procedures for two years for a contract amount of \$500,000, renewable at the City's option for another two years at the City's sole discretion. Centro Legal de la Raza (CLR) responded and submitted a proposal that met the RFP requirements; and

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2023, the City Council authorized a contract with CLR for provision of representation services to low- and moderate-income tenants at RAP Proceedings in the amount of \$250,000 from October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024, renewable at the City Administrator's option for one additional one-year term not to exceed \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2024, the City then executed a contract with CLR for provision of representation services to low- and moderate-income tenants at RAP Proceedings in the amount of \$250,000 from October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2024, the City Administrator, exercising the City's option to extend the contract, signed a contract amendment extending the contract with CLR from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, funding for the first two years of the contract in the amount of \$500,000 is included in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-27 Adopted Biennial budget in Rent Adjustment Program

- Fund (2413), Residential Rent Arbitration Organization (89969), Third Party: Grant Contracts Earned Account (54912), Rent Arbitration P180020 Project (1001110), and that funding for the three option years in the amount of \$750,000 is contingent upon funding availability and the adoption of the future budget cycles; and
- **WHEREAS,** the total contract amount of \$1,000,000 will be charged to the Rent Adjustment Program Fund (Fund 2413), which is restricted to use by the RAP by Ordinance No. 21517 C.M.S.; and
- **WHEREAS**, RAP has an ongoing need for representation services of low- and moderate-income tenants at RAP Proceedings; and
- **WHEREAS**, Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) Section 2.04.051 generally requires a competitive Request for Proposals/Qualifications ("RFP/Q") process for professional services contracts exceeding \$50,000; and
- **WHEREAS**, OMC Section 2.04.051.B allows the City Council to waive the RFP/Q requirements upon a finding that it is in the best interest of the City to do so; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council may waive the Small Local Business Enterprise (SLBE) program requirements pursuant to Part I of Oakland's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise Program Guidelines, last amended by Ordinance No. 13825 (Jan. 6, 2025); and
- **WHEREAS**, waiving the RFP/Q and SLBE program requirements will secure the continuity of services offered by CLR, which is a certified *local* not for profit business but not a "small local" and has the capacity and experience and has successfully and continually partnered with the City to provide those services to low-income tenants since 2013; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Administrator recommends waiving the RFP/Q and SLBE requirements for the contract with CLR and authorizing a one year contract, with an option to renew for up to three years, in the amount not to exceed \$250,000 per year starting on October 1, 2025 and through September 30, 2026, for the first year; and
- WHEREAS, the City Administrator has determined that the services to be provided pursuant to the agreement authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary and shall not result in the loss of salary or employment by any person having permanent status in the competitive civil service; now, therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is authorized to extend the professional services agreement with CLR for provision of representation services to low- and moderate-income tenants at RAP Proceedings for one year with an option to renew for up to three years in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) per year, starting on October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, for the first year, for a total contract amount not to exceed one million dollars (\$1,000,000); and be it
- **FURTHER RESOLVED:** That pursuant to OMC section 2.04.051 and, for the reasons provided herein and in the accompanying staff report, the City Council finds that it is in the best

interests of the City to waive the competitive RFP/Q process and the SLBE program requirements for the agreement and hereby waives the requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to adjust and/or reallocate the per contract year amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) based on operational needs and to modify, extend or amend the professional services agreement without increasing the total contract cost without return to Council.
