A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT TO: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO VANGUARD CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WEST OAKLAND BAY TRAIL (PROJECT NUMBER G134010) IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FORTY-FOUR CENTS (\$479,124.44) REGARDING THE WORKFORCE PROFILE FOR VANGUARD CONSTRUCTION AND THE LISTED

SUBCONTRACTORS

SUMMARY

This supplemental report provides a workforce profile of Vanguard Construction, the recommended prime contractor for the above referenced project and the listed subcontractors, Bond Blacktop (Slurry Seal), RMT Landscape (Landscaping) and Chrisp Company (Signs and Striping). A total workforce of two hundred and seventy-seven (277) was reported. Of that total, 185 (67%) are Hispanic; 74 (27%) are White/not Hispanic; 5% Asian Pacific; 1% Black and 1% American Indian.

FISCAL IMPACT

Since this report is informational only, no fiscal impacts are included.

BACKGROUND

During the April 27, 2004, discussion of the above referenced topic, the Public Works Committee requested a workforce profile of the prime contractor and listed subcontractors.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The prime contractor, Vanguard Construction is a certified local Oakland business. Vanguard reported a total of 76 employees. 86% percent of the workforce is Hispanic.

Three subcontractors were listed. Bond Blacktop (Slurry Seal), RMT Landscape (Landscaping) and Chrisp Company (Signs and Striping). The ethnicity categories reporting at 40% or more of the largest groups are reported as follows: (a) Bond Blacktop reported 36 employees. 88% of the workforce is Hispanic; (b) Chrisp Company reported 89 employees with 47% /white and 31% Hispanic; and (c) RMT is a local certified firm and reported 75 employees. Of that total 91% are Hispanic.

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SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITITES: (As reflected in the April 27, 2004 Report)

Economic: This contract will generate jobs in the local economy. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% Oakland new hires.

<u>Environmental</u>: This project will help reduce air pollution and traffic congestion by encouraging residents to bicycle to work and to use BART, the Dellums Amtrak station and the Alameda/Oakland Ferry in downtown Oakland. The long-term environmental benefits should be considerable, as the bicycle network is completed.

<u>Social Equity</u>: The construction of curb and gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps and the installation of street trees, slurry seal, interpretive signs, and bicycle lanes will benefit the immediate neighborhood. The project supports the development of a pedestrian-friendly city as well as clean and livable neighborhoods. The bicycle lanes will promote physical exercise in an area currently difficult to access by cyclists.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS (As reflected in the April 27, 2004 Report)

This project includes accessibility improvements. The construction of sidewalk and curb ramps will improve access to city streets and sidewalks for senior citizens, persons with disabilities and all pedestrians in general. Curb ramps will be constructed to current state and federal standards.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO VANGUARD CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WEST OAKLAND BAY TRAIL (PROJECT NUMBER G134010) IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FORTY-

FOUR CENTS (\$479,124.44)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared for Council approval that authorizes the award of a contract to Vanguard Construction for the construction of West Oakland Bay Trail (Project No. G134010) in the amount of \$479,124.44. Vanguard Construction is the lowest responsible bidder and has met the project's goals. Funds are available for this contract.

This project is consistent with the Mayor and City Council Goals to Maintain and Enhance Oakland's Physical Assets and to Improve Oakland's Neighborhoods. The project is located in Council District 3.

It is recommended that the resolution be approved.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for this project has been secured from Transportation Development Activities fund (TDA), Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA), Measure 'B' funds, Municipal Capital Improvement funds (MCI) for Hazardous Material, and Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) Bay Trail Grant. (See table below.)

The engineer's estimate for the work is \$534,151.00 and the construction contract will be in the amount of \$479,124.44. There is \$669,076 available in Organization 92242, Construction Contract Account (57411), Projects G134020, G134040, C181210, and G181710 for the construction work and contingencies, distributed as follows:

Also, there are adequate funds in the project for construction engineering and project management. Fees for Public Art and Contract Compliance will be allocated in the appropriate project accounts.

ABAG requires hiring of the East Bay Conservation Corps (EBCC) for tree planting and maintenance services in this project. Therefore, the contractor (Vanguard Construction) will hire EBCC under his supervision to plant trees along 2nd Street. The City will later enter into a separate three-year maintenance contract with EBCC to provide tree maintenance, with oversight provided by the Office of Parks and Recreation. The cost for the maintenance contract is \$32,000 and funds are available for this work.

BACKGROUND

On February 6, 2004, Notices to Bidders were sent to 55 contractors and notices were placed in the Oakland Tribune advertising for bids for the project. On March 1, 2004, the following bids were received for the project by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland:

^{*} The total Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirement is 20%.

There will be LBE/SLBE participation of \$397,466.44 (82.96%), which exceeds the city's 20% requirement. In addition, the contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of new hires to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Manager's Office and is shown on *Attachment A*.

The West Oakland Bay Trail Project is a link in the San Francisco Bay Trail, a bicycle and pedestrian facility that will circle the San Francisco Bay. The proposed work consists of the construction of bicycle lanes, sidewalks, street trees, public art and historical and bicycle signage along the route.

This project extends along 3rd Street between Union Street and Brush Street; Brush Street between 3rd Street and 2nd Street; and 2nd Street between Brush Street and Broadway. It will connect to an existing Bay

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Trail segment, which extends from 2nd Street and Broadway, along the waterfront on Embarcadero, and ends at the east end of the Park Street Bridge to the City of Alameda.

The project will also connect with a recently constructed segment of Bay Trail on the new 3rd Street extension from Kirkham to Mandela Parkway (7th Street), pending Amtrak's completion of a one-block gap between Kirkham and Union. Another city Bay Trail project is closing the gap in bicycle and pedestrian facilities between 7th and 8th Streets on Mandela Parkway (by Summer 2005). In addition, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) expects to complete the Bay Trail link from 8th Street on Mandela to the Emeryville border by Fall 2006. Once completed, the West Oakland Bay Trail will form a continuous bicycle and pedestrian facility, with trees and historic markers, from Broadway to the Emeryville border. Further, the city is enhancing the West Oakland Bay Trail by providing a "way finding map" sign and rest stop, as part of the Cypress Memorial Park between 13th and 14th Streets (to be completed by Summer 2005).

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction work is scheduled to begin in June 2004 and will be completed by August 2004. The contract specifies \$1,000 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time of 45 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is also shown on *Attachment B*.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: This contract will generate jobs in the local economy. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of new hires to be Oakland residents.

<u>Environmental</u>: This project will help reduce air pollution and traffic congestion by encouraging residents to bicycle to work and to use BART, the Dellums Amtrak station and the Alameda/Oakland Ferry in downtown Oakland. The long-term environmental benefits should be considerable, as the bicycle network is completed.

In addition, there will be utilization of recyclable materials within the concrete and asphalt concrete construction materials to the extent possible. Planting of street trees will improve air quality.

<u>Social Equity:</u> The construction of curb and gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps and the installation of street trees, slurry seal, interpretive signs, and bicycle lanes will benefit the immediate neighborhood. The project supports the development of a pedestrian-friendly city as well as clean and livable neighborhoods. The bicycle lanes will promote physical exercise in an area currently difficult to access by cyclists.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

This project includes accessibility improvements. The construction of sidewalk and curb ramps will improve access to city streets and sidewalks for senior citizens, persons with disabilities and all pedestrians in general. Curb ramps will be constructed to current state and federal standards.



RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the City Council approve a resolution authorizing the award of a contract to Vanguard Construction for the construction of West Oakland Bay Trail (Project No. G134010) in the amount of \$479,124.44. Vanguard Construction has met the LBE/SLBE requirement, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.
