**RESOLUTION APPOINTING _____ TO FILL THE
VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY FOR
THE BALANCE OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM, WHICH RUNS
UNTIL 11 A.M. ON MONDAY, JANUARY 7, 2013**

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that the City Attorney shall be elected every four years; and

WHEREAS, former City Attorney John Russo was elected to serve a four-year term for the period commencing Monday, January 5, 2009, and ending at 11:00 a.m. on January 7, 2013; and

WHEREAS, former City Attorney Russo resigned as City Attorney effective June 13, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2011, the City Council passed Resolution No. 83393 declaring the Office of the City Attorney vacant as of June 13, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that the Council shall make an appointment to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term within 60 days after such Office shall become vacant; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter further provides that City Council shall hold a special election to fill the vacancy if it fails to make an appointment by the end of the sixty day appointment period; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make an appointment to fill the office for the balance of the unexpired term; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that in accordance with the powers granted by City Charter §401(4), the Council of the City of Oakland hereby appoints _____ as City Attorney to fill

the vacancy in the Office of the City Attorney for the balance of the unexpired four-year term, which runs until 11:00 a.m., January 7, 2013.
