

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CLAIM OF PAUL TRAVER, CITY ATTORNEY'S CLAIM NO. C30094, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$23,400.00), PAYABLE TO PAUL TRAVER (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT - VEHICLE COLLISION)

WHEREAS, claimant alleges that on February 11, 2014, the City driver collided into the claimant's building, and

WHEREAS, the claimant filed the above entitled claim seeking payment for said damages, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has determined that settlement in this amount, without an admission of liability, is in the best interest of the City; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to settle the claim of Paul Traver in the amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$23,400.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Twenty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$23,400.00) be made payable to Paul Traver.
