WHEREAS, from 1994 through 2000, the Redevelopment Agency's funds were used to meet the matching funds requirements under the federal HOME Investment Partnership Program ("HOME"); and

WHEREAS, HOME regulations require that recaptured matching funds be used for HOME-eligible activities; and

WHEREAS, the MAP no longer meets the requirements to be considered a HOME-eligible activity; and

WHEREAS, to date the MAP has generated \$619,536 to the Agency in repayments of loans originally funded with Redevelopment Agency matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency's Housing Development Program funds HOMEeligible activities; and WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency desires to use recaptured MAP funds for the Housing Development Program; now, therefore, be it
