

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601 the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's following appointments to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities:

Olivia de Jimenez, for a three-year term beginning September 3, 2014 and ending September 2, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Lorraine Rosenblatt;

Brandon Young, for a three-year term beginning September 3, 2015 and ending September 2, 2018, filling the seat previously held by Fatimah Aure;

Preet Anand, for a three-year term beginning October 19, 2014 and ending October 18, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Phyllis Stevenson; and

Sarah Garner, for a three-year term beginning September 3, 2014 and ending September 2, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Miquette Thompson.
