

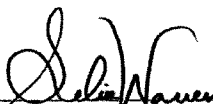

RESOLUTION NO. 91279 C.M.S.

INTRODUCED BY THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OAKLAND FUND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED AND TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$202,500) FOR A COMPREHENSIVE INDEPENDENT AUDIT OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND'S TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, technology, including both systems and data, is the underlying infrastructure that connects multiple departments and agencies together and the basis upon which many of the City of Oakland's basic services depend; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland operates numerous software, hardware, and digital systems across its departments, many of which are not consistently integrated with one another; and

WHEREAS, recent City Council hearings on citywide staffing have identified significant technology barriers in the City's recruiting and hiring processes, including disconnected systems that require extensive manual processing and paper-based workflows between departments; and

WHEREAS, the City's contracting and procurement process faces comparable technology challenges, with manual workflows spanning requisition, solicitation, vendor selection, contract execution, compliance monitoring, and payment; and

WHEREAS, an independent comprehensive technology audit will produce a complete inventory of City technology assets, an end-to-end assessment of integration gaps across City operations, and a prioritized decision matrix to guide remediation efforts; and

WHEREAS, the audit will be conducted by a qualified and properly vetted independent consulting firm and any contract procured as a result of this funding will follow the Oakland Municipal Code, including returning to Council for approval if waivers of the competitive process or Local/Small Local Business Enterprise program requirements are sought; and

WHEREAS, The Oakland Fund has awarded \$202,500 to the City of Oakland to fund the independent technology audit; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby accepts and appropriates grant funds from The Oakland Fund in an amount not to exceed two hundred two thousand five hundred dollars (\$202,500) for the conduct of a comprehensive independent audit of the City of Oakland's technology systems; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That funding will be used for the consulting services contract, related project expenses, and administrative costs associated with the audit; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: The funding will be deposited in Fund 2999 – Miscellaneous Grants, Project (TBD); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations and documentation required to accept the grant funding.

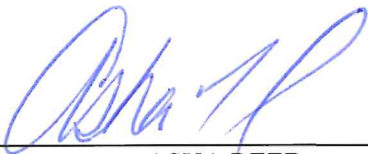
