**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CALPERS) TO INCLUDE A ONE PERCENT (1%) EMPLOYEES COST SHARING OF ADDITIONAL BENEFITS FOR TIER I AND TIER II CLASSIC POLICE MEMBERS (CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 20516)**
