To the extent practical, the working group should reflect the geographic and racial diversity of the City of Oakland, and be composed of city staff, community stakeholders, expert advisors, funding experts and other relevant contributors as determined by the city administrator or their designee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: The City Administrator, or their designee, shall establish a structure to coordinate as appropriate Urban Forest Plan implementation efforts between city staff, local volunteer groups and outside experts and contractors; and be it

- On Page 3, Of The Fourth Further Resolve Clause:

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council directs the City Administrator or designee to report annually on the implementation progress, including, but not limited to, status updates on funding opportunities identified and secured to implement the UFP, and areas that remain incomplete, as well as additional recommendations as to what further actions or resources likely are needed for completion; and be it
