A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR PUBLIC STREET RENAMING

WHEREAS, the City's street renaming policy was established in an Engineering Services Directive dated December 15, 1995 and officially adopted by motion of the City Council on January 16, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to establish new criteria for the renaming of public streets; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council may, by its own motion, consider the renaming of a public street as a tribute to an individual, or as a result of a significant event or activity, if the following criteria is met:

- 1. The individual has positively impacted the lives of a nation or the world;
- 2. The name change is related to an economic development or redevelopment activity;
- 3. The renaming commemorates a significant historical event.
