RESOLUTION CALLING FOR 10% REDUCTION IN ELECTRIC ENERGY USAGE IN CITY FACILITIES AND OPERATIONS
WHEREAS , the State of California is currently confronting a critical threat to its statewide energy system; and
WHEREAS, the State has experienced rolling blackouts and Stage 3 energy emergencies for the past two weeks; and
WHEREAS, the shortage of energy resources cannot be solved without the cooperation of every person and institution in the State; and
WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is a major consumer of energy and has a leadership role in setting an example of energy conservation; now therefore be it
RESOLVED: that the City Council calls upon the City Manager to reduce energusage by 10% in City facilities and operations, and to create a program and operations plan for all City departments to implement immediately to reach this goal; and be it
FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Manager will report to the City Council regularly on the progress of this emergency program.
