RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Receive An Informational Report On The Budget Status Of The Funds in Measure "B", Measure "BB" And "Vehicle Registration Fees," Including Specifically: (1) The June 2016 Fund Balance For Each Of These Three Funds (2) Actual Expenditures And Revenues For The Year '15-'16 For Each, (3) Budgeted Expenditure And Revenue For The Years 15'-16' And '16-'17 For Each, (4) The Remaining Unexpended Fund Balance Now Projected In The Revised Budget For June 2017 And (5) If Any Of The Fund Balance Is Allocated But Not Yet Spent, A List Of **Specific Projects To Which The Funds Are Allocated.**

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

The purpose of this supplemental report is to provide additional information on non-project budget amounts funded by Measure B, Measure BB and Vehicle Registration Funds, as requested by the Public Works Committee.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

On July 12, 2016, the Public Works Committee received a report on budget and expenditures in FY 15-16 and 16-17 for Measure B, Measure BB and Vehicle Registration Funds. Three attachments were provided, which provided a summary of overall fund balances and budgeted amounts, a list of projects funded by these sources, fund balances and status of projects with balances over \$100,000.

The Committee requested additional information on non-project budgeted amounts; the attached table (Attachment A) summarizes non-project budget allocations approved by the City Council in the 2015-17 Policy Budget. Programs and activities that are funded by these sources include:

Bureau of Engineering and Construction: Traffic Safety, Transportation Planning, Engineering Services, Funding for Department of Transportation, Dues to Alameda County Transportation Commission.
