**Ordinance Amending Oakland Municipal Code 10.48.010, Schedule of Parking Fines, to Increase the Fines for Violations of Oakland Traffic Code Sections 10.16.070 "Parking on Private Property"; 10.28.020 "No Parking in Parkway"; 10.28.040A "Over 18" from Curb"; "10.28.040 "Parking Vehicle Wrong on a One-Way Street"; 10.28.040D "Parking within Parking Space Markings"; 10.28.050 "Angle Parking within Markings"; 10.28.250 "No Parking Any Time"; 10.32.030 "Parking for Official Cars – City Hall"; 10.32.100 "Parking for Official Cars – Police & County"; 10.32.130 "Parking for Official Cars – Fire"; 10.32.140 "Parking for Official Cars – County"; 10.32.150 "Parking for Official Cars – U.S. mail vehicle"; 10.32.170 "Parking by Permit – City Cars & Authorized City Cars"; 10.32.020 "Parking over Space Markings"; 10.36.030 "Meters – Depositing Coins"; 10.36.050 "Meters Violation – Expired"; 10.36.060 "Meter – Overtime Meter Feeding"; 10.36.100 "Meter-Expired – Off-Street Meter"**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland wishes to preserve the livability, social, and economic stability of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland has a duty to enforce parking violations as set forth by the Oakland Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland collects revenues used to support a multitude of public services from fines resulting from parking violations; and

**WHEREAS**, the increase parking fines will help to support the City's parking enforcement and related activities; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was conducted on June 5, 2003 to review the proposed fine increases; and, hearing no objection

**NOW THEREFORE**, The City Council for the City of Oakland does ordain as follows:

Oakland Municipal Code Section 10.48.010, **Schedule of Parking Fines**, is hereby amended to add, delete, or modify sections as set forth below (additions are indicated by underscoring and deletions are indicated by ~~strike-through~~ type; portions of the ordinances not cited or not shown in underscoring or strike-through type are not changed).
