RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$115,000) IN U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING LAW ENFORCEMENT SPECIALIZED UNITS PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE FAMILY VIOLENCE LAW CENTER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$447,500) FOR FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Governor's Office of Criminal Justice Planning has advised the City Manager that the City of Oakland has been awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000) to fund a Domestic Violence Prevention Program, and

WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of 25% of the total project (\$38,333) will be provided by Alameda County Social Services Agency, for a total of \$153,333; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice funds will be leveraged with funding from the 2002 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) and the State COPS VII grant previously adopted by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Specialized Units Program monies and the leveraged funds noted above will be used to enter into a contract with the Family Violence Law Center in order to expand, refine and enhance the Police Department's Domestic Violence Prevention Program; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department requests authorization to negotiate a Professional Service Agreement with Family Violence Law Center in an amount not to exceed four hundred forty-seven thousand, five hundred dollars (\$447,500) for family violence prevention, case management, legal advocacy, and crisis management; and

WHEREAS, the Family Violence Prevention Program will facilitate the City Council's goal of crime reduction through City-wide community policing and other strategies; and

WHEREAS, the services provided pursuant to the agreement authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific, or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this agreement shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; and

WHEREAS, contracts requiring professional or specialized services are exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Chapter 2.04 of the Oakland Municipal Code; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or her designee to accept the Law Enforcement Specialized Units program grant in the amount not to exceed one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said grant monies shall be maintained in the State of California Fund: 2159, Org.: 102410; in a Project Account to be determined, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager or her designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend this grant agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract with the Family Violence Law Center is a professional service for which the calling of bids would serve no useful purpose, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby finds and determines that services provided pursuant to the contract authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Family Violence Law Center for family violence prevention, case management, legal advocacy, and crisis intervention associated with the Domestic Violence Program sponsored by the United States Department of Justice in an amount not to exceed \$447,500 for the period July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any further documents necessary to implement this resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is authorized to modify, extend or amend said agreement provided that no additional funds will be allocated without prior Council approval; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreement shall be reviewed by the City Attorney as to form and legality and a copy placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
