Subject: Ordinance to Amend the City of Oakland's Conflict of Interest Code (Ordinance No. 11562 C.M.S., as amended, Oakland Municipal Code, Chapter 3.16)

The City Council is the Code Reviewing Body for the City of Oakland's Conflict of Interest Code pursuant to the Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 87306.5. Additionally, the City Council is required to conduct a comprehensive bi-annual review of the code and make revisions if needed. That review took place in December 2002 and the City Council adopted an updated code. The attached ordinance is intended to address employee positions changes that have occurred since the last updated.

The Office of the City Auditor and the Public Works Agency have notified the City Clerk and City Attorney that amendments to the code are required because of employee position changes. The City Attorney's Office reviewed the code and determined that the requested changes are necessary.

Attached for your review and consideration is an ordinance that amends the Conflict of Interest Code and Appendices for the Office of the City Auditor and the Public Works Agency.

This office recommends that you adopt the attached ordinance.
