RESOLUTION APPOINTING FREDERICK REMER AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 72727 C.M.S., as amended, creates the Community Policing Advisory Board to advise and make recommendations on matters related to the City's implementation of its community policing program; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 73916 C.M.S. specifies the terms of members of the Community Policing Advisory Board and provides that no member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, members of the Community Policing Advisory Board are appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the City Council pursuant to City Charter section 601, and the Honorable Mayor Ronald V. Dellums appoints Frederick Remer to serve a three-year term on the Community Policing Advisory Board; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, and based on the recommendation by Council President Jane Brunner (District 1), the Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Frederick Remer to the Community Policing Advisory Board for the three-year term beginning March 24, 2008 and ending March 23, 2011, filing the seat previously held by Charles Porter.
