RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO RENAME BAMBINO FIELD LOCATED AT THE GREENMAN FIELD COMPLEX TO THE OAKLAND ATHLETICS BAMBINO FIELD FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS

WHEREAS, the Oakland Athletics Baseball Company donated funds to the Good Tidings Foundation to finance the construction of repairs, to install turf and to make other improvements to renovate Bambino Baseball Field located at the Greenman Field Complex on 66th Avenue, Oakland, CA; and

WHEREAS, the improvements to the field were completed in August 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Athletics Baseball Company is committed to supporting Oakland youth in team sports participation; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Athletics Baseball Company exhibits community engagement, civic responsibility, and social involvement; and

WHEREAS, Bambino Field is the designated baseball field for youth championship games and regular youth league games, and

WHEREAS, the proposed renaming is consistent with Resolution No. 65024 governing the renaming of City facilities; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to rename the Bambino Baseball Field to the Oakland Athletics Bambino Field for a period of ten years; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Office of the City Attorney has approved this resolution as to form and legality, and a copy will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
