## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$192,000 IN FY 2002-03 TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR FUNDS FOR THE COLISEUM BART PEDESTRIAN CROSSING TRAFFIC SIGNAL

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Health and Safety Code Sections 44225 and 44241, the City of Oakland is an eligible applicant for funding available from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's (BAAQMD) Transportation Fund for Clean Air; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency (CMA) is the designated program manager for the annual allocation of local TFCA program revenues; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Public Works Agency wishes to apply to the CMA for \$192,000 in FY 2002-03 TFCA funds for the Coliseum BART Pedestrian Crossing Traffic Signal to support clean air and reduce traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, the construction of transit improvements and pedestrian facilities is consistent with the goals of the City's General Plan; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**: That the City Council authorizes the application, acceptance and appropriation of \$192,000 in FY 2002-03 local TFCA funds; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute and submit all documents, payment requests and related actions, for the completion of the aforementioned project; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That should additional funds be received for this project, the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate the same for the purposes described above.
