

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE  
CITY OF OAKLAND GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON  
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2006**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to State law and Section 1101 of the Charter of the City of Oakland, a General Municipal Election was duly and regularly held in the City of Oakland on Tuesday, November 7, 2006.

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk caused to be canvassed the election returns of said consolidated election pursuant to law; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk does hereby certify the results for the General Municipal Election; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**: that the City Council orders and declares the results of the canvass of the returns of said General Municipal Election to be as follows:

The names of the candidates for the Office of Councilmember, District No. 2 are as follows:

**Measure authorizing the issuance of \$148,000,000 in bonds to construct a new main library, acquire land, and construct new branch library facilities and to renovate and expand branch library facilities**

**PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT**

**MEASURE O**

**Measure amending the Charter of the City of Oakland to require use of ranked choice voting known sometimes as instant runoff voting, to elect city offices by a majority vote at a November election without holding a prior June election**

NO	29,299

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, determined and declared that Measures M and O are hereby declared to have passed; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, determined and declared that Measure N is hereby declared to have failed; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, determined and declared that the canvass of the returns of said General Municipal Election show that the total number of ballots cast at the General Municipal Election was **110,006 (60.23%)** of the registered voters and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Clerk is hereby ordered to issue certificates of election to all persons herein declared elected; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Council orders and declares that the Official Canvass Summary report on file in the Office of the City Clerk, containing within the number of votes cast at each precinct for each candidate and for and against each measure, be and is hereby adopted.


